WHEN: Saturday, December 6th, 5:40 PM (parade starts at 6:00 PM)

WHERE: Parade participants will line up near Paddock & Milan Middle School. (Do NOT drop dancers off at the studio.) We will not know our exact location in the line-up until the evening of the parade upon check-in. Simply look for the large, black-enclosed Dance Xplosion trailer. Volunteers will be available to guide you.

WHAT TO BRING: Extra warm clothing worn **UNDER** your white parade shirts, and your winter ribbon wand. Please keep your attire to white and blue if possible. If you weren't able to make a shirt or wand at float building, we have extras! Stop by the office to pick up an extra.

WHO: All DX Dancers!! An adult must accompany dancers 8 yrs and younger. All parents are welcome to join us.

Dancers should be picked up at the end of the parade route by Marble Memorial United Methodist Church, across from the post office. All dancers need to be picked up directly following the parade and will not be brought back to the studio for pick up.
